Why and how you can help your cub benefit from the Canadian Path(CP)

Why: The CP mandates that the cub determines the what and how for the completion of any or all of the 16 Personal Achievement Badges(PAB). Completions are totally optional however, there are many life skills development benefits to be gained by working on as many of the 16 as they wish. The cubs were provided with detailed copies explaining the badges and steps to earn(they are also available on Scout tracker). The descriptions are only suggestions. The selection of what to do is totally the idea and choice of the cub.

How: Your involvement is key. Your cub is very busy with school and other areas. We are asking you to keep the objectives and requirements of PAB in front of your cub. Reminding and monitoring would work but discussion and encouragement would be optimal. We need your involvement for the the best results. What could be better than helping your cub complete their own ideas. Please mentor only let them do the work.

Please ask any leader for clarification. Each cub will have a leader as a mentor throughout the plan...do...review process. We are asking for each cub to do at least 1 PAB but again, it's totally optional. We have asked for a selection of a badge(s) by the 9 Jan 2018, where each cub will share their choice with the pack. There are no set requirements on size and content of the badge report. This is the cubs choice but the essence of the badge must be shown and agreed to by the cub-mentor team.
